

CLEANING VINYL in 6 Steps

Tools You'll Need:

- Clean, dry microfiber cloths
- Bucket or spray bottle
- Sponge, cloth, or soft-bristle brush

Preparation:

- Clear the area to be cleaned of any debris or obstacles.
- Ventilate the space to effectively dry the material later

Dilution:

- Dilute Woolite detergent with water, using 1 part detergent per 3 parts water, a 1:3 ratio.

Application:

- First, test the cleaner in a small, inconspicuous area first to ensure compatibility.
